## ARTHUR HASTINGS BOSTOCK GENEALOGY

The Bostock family has deep roots into the Royal Plantagenets, being related through marriage to the Southey Family.

This branch of the Bostock family is from Horsham in England. The family is well known for producing well educated sons, a number of whom became surgeons <sup>1</sup> and officers (or both) in the British Army.

4.2.3 **Dr. Arthur Hastings Bostock (AHB)** born on 6 November 1876 <sup>8</sup> in Chichester, Sussex, England, died on 14 January 1958 in Chichester, Sussex.

He married **Alice Richardson** in Wandsworth, London in 1923. She was born in 1880, the daughter of Samuel and Sarah Richardson, and died on 11 April 1948 in Chichester, Sussex.

She was twice married; first to Major John Simeon Warde for whom she bore two children: Diana Mary Warde and John Simeon Warde. Thereafter, she married Dr. Arthur Hastings Bostock. They had no issue.

AHB was educated at Radley College. He qualified as a doctor at St. Bartholomew's Hospital Medical College and was registered 11 May 1900 as a Member of the Royal College of Surgeons (England) and Licentiate of the Royal College of Physicians of London. When first registering to practice as a general practitioner-surgeon, he resided at 10 Southgate, Chichester, Sussex, England.

He served as a Civilian Surgeon in Natal, South Africa, during the Second Anglo-Boer War (1899-1902), for which service he was awarded the Queen's South Africa Medal (bar Natal).

The 1901 Census of England and Wales has him resident in St. Pancras, London. At that time, he was a house-physician at St. Bartholomew's Hospital. On completing that duty, he moved to Chichester where he entered general practice and later added to that the functions of district medical officer. He served the district as a general practitioner-surgeon, holding appointments at the West Sussex, Graylingwell Mental Hospitals and King Edward VII Sanatorium, Midhurst.

During World War I he joined the Royal Army Medical Corp and served with the British Expeditionary Forces in France.

He was Chairman of the West Sussex Hospital Medical Staff Committee and the Chichester & Wathling Division of the British Medical Association between 1930 - 1932.

He retired in 1947

"The memory of the colourful personality will long live in the City of Chichester and the surrounding countryside".
