ALBERT SOPHRON SIEGER

Albert Sophron Sieger was born 17 August 1874. He first registered as a practitioner 27 April 1899 having qualified out of Edinburgh and Glasgow: LRCP (Edin) 1899 LRCS (Edin) 1899 LFPS (Glasg) 1899. After the South African War he went on to earn a DPH RCPS (Edin) 1903 and FPS (Glasg) 1903. His name last appears in the Medical Directory in 1937.

His brother, Edward Louis Augustine Sieger, was also a medical practitioner qualifying on $9^{\rm th}$ November 1905 with a MB., ChB (U Glasg). He and his brother practised from 19 Grey Place, Greenock.

The circumstances of A S Sieger serving in the Anglo-Boer War 1899-1902 are not known. He left South Africa on 26 July 1902 on board the Tintagel Castle. He was awarded the Queen's South Africa Medal bars: Cape Colony, SA'01, SA '02 [inscribed A.S. SIEGER Surgeon].
