CAPE GARRISON ARTILLERY

The Cape Garrison Artillery and Engineer Corps was formed in 1891, taking the place of the Cape Engineers or Cape Town Volunteer Engineers. From 1897, it became known as the Cape Garrison Artillery. The first commanding officer was Major le Vicomte de Montfort. It consisted of 4 companies of artillery and one of engineers and the authorized establishment was 320 ranks. It drew trainers from the Royal Garrison Artillery. The badge was that of the Cape of Good Hope, the motto "*Spes Bona*".

From 1898, it was run on a partially-paid basis and lost its volunteer status. It was mobilized in 1899, expanded in size with some recruits arriving from overseas. Part of the unit joined Kirchener's Horse on active duty during the Anglo-Boer War. On 30th June 1902, the unit was demobilised and continued as a part-time unit. It has undergone many transformations from that time to this.

The meaning of the name : a man that repairs bones

It should be noted that in the South African context there appears to be little genealogical significance in persons spelling their names BOONZAAIER or BOONZAIER in that the spellings are frequently interchanged between generations and siblings. However, as a broad generalisation the former is used in the platteland-based Afrikaner group and the latter amongst the Anglicised group in Cape Town and vicinity. The spellings BOONZAAYER and BOONZAAÿER have essentially fallen away.
